**Consultancy Services for the preparation of National coastal zone adaptation strategy for the Republic of Mauritius**

### Addendum No 1

#### 1. Query:

Whether foreign consultants as defined in the CIDB Act will have to apply for and obtain a provisional Registration prior to submitting proposals as per clause 1.8.1 (c)?

#### Answer:

Section 1.8.1 (a) of the RFP document states that **only** Consultants involved in Architecture, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Project Management in Construction and Quantity Surveying in the construction Sector have to be duly registered with the CIDB.

This RFP is for developing a strategy and does not involve the services of specialists in the above fields, therefore registration with CIDB is **NOT** Mandatory.

2. The closing date for submission of the proposals is being extended by one (1) week. The proposals must therefore be submitted not later than **Monday 26 September 2016 at 13.30 hrs (local time)** to the address mentioned at clause 4.5 of the Data Sheet.
